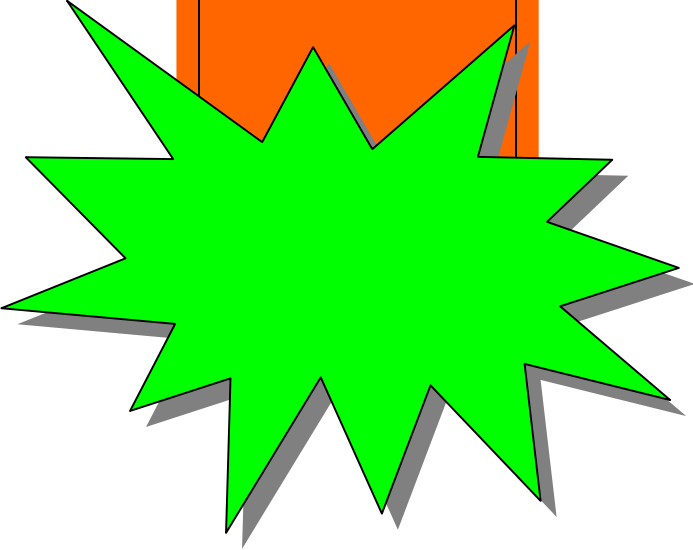
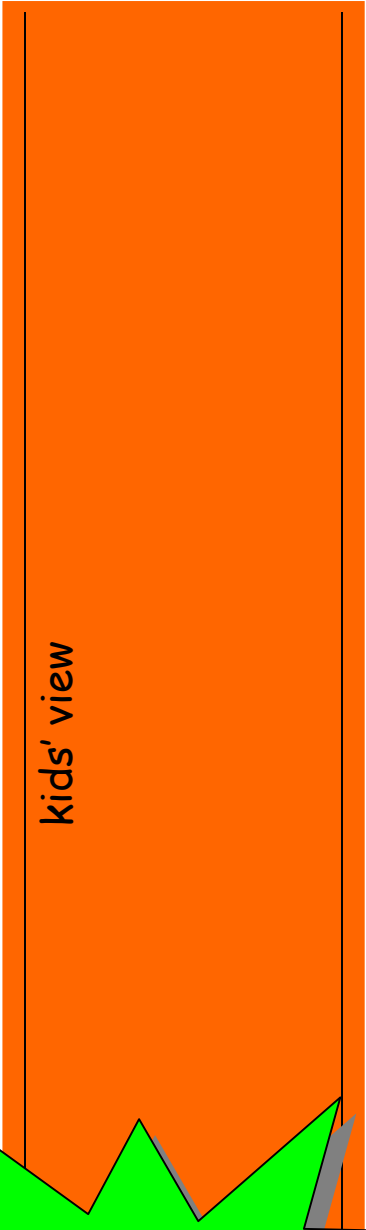

You should have film for at least 26 photographs in your camera.

Please take one photo of the people, places and things in your world which are described below. **ASK YOUR PARENTS OR CAREGIVER BEFORE PHOTOGRAPHING STRANGERS OR GOING INTO ANYONE'S HOME!**

You don't have to take the pictures in the order in which they're listed, but be sure that you've photographed everything that's on the list. We have included a Worksheet on Page 7 to help you keep track of the photos you have taken.

People In *Your* World

Take a picture of each of the following people. It can be someone in your school, neighborhood, community or home. They can be grown-ups or kids. Then write whom you took a picture of, and why. Include how you know this person, if you do at all. For example, is it your friend? sister? uncle? a store keeper? neighbor? a stranger? You can even ask someone to take a picture of *yourself* if you think the description fits you best of all.

- Photo 1 Who Takes Care of Us?
The person who does the most to take care of everything and everybody.
- Photo 2 Who Has Been Left Out?
The person (or people) who **doesn't** have anyone to take care of them...they feel left out or excluded. Someone who's not being well cared-for, but who **needs** care.
- Photo 3 A Hero or Heroine

The person in your life who you most admire. A leader who can be looked up to.

- Photo 4 A Friend of Kids
The adult person who likes kids a lot, and likes to be with them.
- Photo 5 Rebel
The rebel in your neighborhood, community or home who doesn't follow the crowd.
- Photo 6 Troublemaker
The real troublemaker in your neighborhood, community or home.
- Photo 7 Magician
The person or people who bring "magic" into your life, who make things special for you, or makes you feel special.
- Photo 8 Wise One
The wisest person you know. You like to get his or her advice.
- Photo 9 Joker
The joker in your neighborhood, community or home. He or she sees humor in everything, and doesn't take life too seriously.
- Photo 10 A Regular Kid
He or she doesn't stand out in any way, but they are friendly and normal.
- Photo 11 The Kid-Hater
The adult person who doesn't like kids, and doesn't like to be with them.

Places in *Your* World

- Photo 12 Heart of Your Home
The place in your home or apartment where people most like to relax and be together.
- Photo 13 The Place For Kids
A place *other than your home or school* where you and your friends like to go to have fun and be together.
- Photo 14 Your Hide-Out
The place in your home where *you* like to go to feel cozy and secure.
- Photo 15 Your Favorite Thing
Something in your home -- other than people or pets -- that means the most to you personally.
- Photo 16: The Safe Place
The place where you feel nothing bad can happen to you.
- Photo 17: The Scary Place
The place where you feel most afraid.

Your View Of The Future

- Photo 18 Hopes
Something in your neighborhood, community or home that ***makes you feel excited*** about the future.
- Photo 19 Worries
Something in your neighborhood, community or home that makes you feel worried about the future.
- Photo 20 What Makes You Proud?
Something that shows what's good about America and makes you proud to be an American.
- Photo 21 What Makes You Ashamed?
Something that's not good about America, that makes you feel ashamed to be an American.

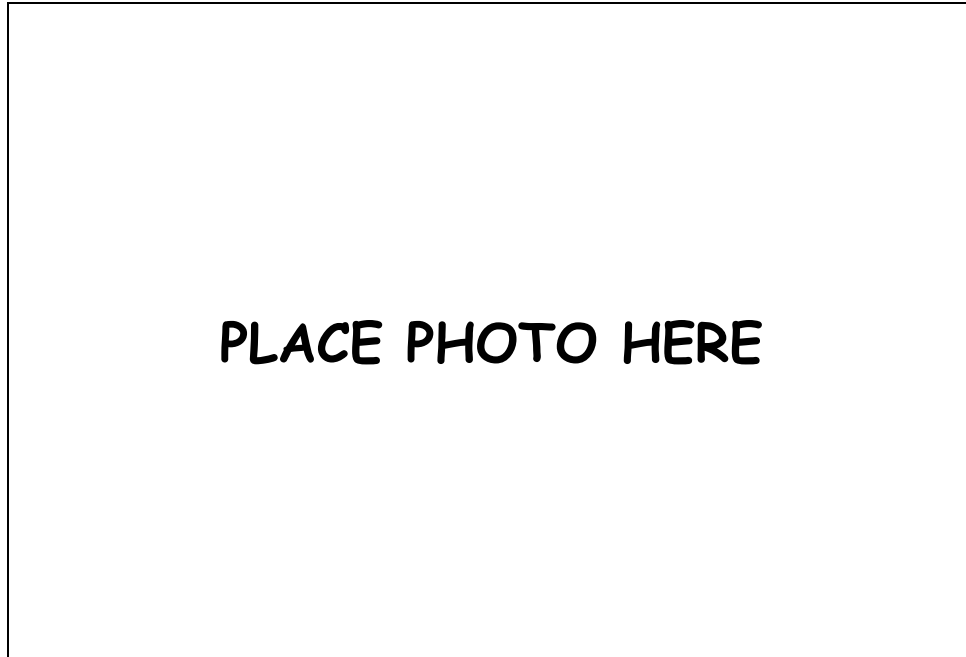

What does the photograph mean to you?

When you're sure everything has been completed properly, you may want to place the negatives in a plastic sleeve for safekeeping.
